Approval of the Agenda: CP Brooks made a motion to approve the Agenda, with CP Moye seconding. Motion passed.


NEW BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS: City Manager Hicks recommended to award the contract for Disaster Debris Recovery services related to C & D from Hurricane Michael to Pride Contracting Inc. After reviewing all received bids, City Manager Hicks stated that Pride Contracting Inc. scored the highest in overall ratings. Pride Contracting Inc. is fully aware that the debris removal project has a completion date of June 10, 2019. City Manager Hicks stated that if awarded and once Pride Contracting Inc. provides all the necessary paperwork, the debris removal project will begin immediately in order to meet the June 10, 2019 deadline. After some discussion, CP Brooks made a motion to award Pride Contracting Inc. the contract for Disaster Debris Recovery services related to C & D from Hurricane Michael. CP Moye seconded; motion carried.


