**Official Minutes**

Mayor Ron Johnson, Jr. called the Called Council Meeting to order at 5:00 PM in the Council Chambers at City Hall. **NEW BUSINESS**

NEW BUSINESS: City Manager Hicks stated that the following bids were received Friday June 26, 2020 at 2:00 PM related to the new Gas Line Project:

Little River Contracting - \$330,455  
Equix - \$497,248  
Harrison Harris - \$484,440

City Manager Hicks stated that the above amounts cover the cost of Phase 1, which includes APGG and the Scott Farms operation on Hwy 39. The City will utilize these prices to amend the contract to include the Scott Farms operation on Hwy 84. City Manager Hicks also stated that this would bring the total project cost to approximately \$440,000-\$450,000, including engineering (using the low bid numbers). City Manager Hicks stated that the budget for the project is \$450,000.00. City Manager Hicks then recommended approving Resolution 06-29-20, providing for the award of a bid for the construction of gas supply lines to Little River Contractors Inc. in the amount of \$330,455.00 and authorization to execute one or more qualified financing documents for the construction of the lines. 


