Official Minutes

Mayor Pro Tem Bond called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM in the Council Chambers at City Hall. After which, Probate Judge Michael Rogerson affirmed appointed Councilmember Flossie Smith.

Mayor Pro Tem Bond then commenced the Public Hearing at 5:03 PM and opened the floor for any discussion of the upcoming FY 2016-2017 Budget. Staff present were City Manager Steve Hicks, City Clerk Christina Corvers, and Police Chief Woodrow Blue. No other guests were present. Manager Steve Hicks made a brief discussion on the upcoming Budget, and with there being no further comments or discussion on the topic, Mayor Pro Tem Bond adjourned the Public Hearing at 5:05 PM.

Next, Mayor Pro Tem Bond called the Called Council Meeting to order at 5:05 PM in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Pro Tem Bond then gave the invocation, after which all joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America.

CP Blanks made a motion to approve the agreement as per recommendation of GMA; CP Buczek made a second, motion passed.

With there being no further business to come before the Council, at 5:31 P.M. CP Register moved to adjourn, seconded by CP Smith. Motion carried.
