

PUBLIC NOTICE
OF
LEVEL 1 DROUGHT RESPONSE

As directed by the Rules for Drought Management, Chapter 391-3-30 (Drought Rule), the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has been monitoring climatic indicators and water supply conditions to assess drought and severity. Drought conditions continue to worsen in many areas of Georgia. A Level 1 Drought Response has been declared for 58 Georgia counties for permittees using surface and/or groundwater that includes Seminole County and the City of Donalsonville.

In compliance with the Level 1 Drought Response the City of Donalsonville is required to implement a public information campaign and notify citizens of the actions to be taken and practices to be observed for water use as follows:

- General outdoor watering is allowed only between 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.
- Applies to commercial and residential water use, not just outdoor watering
Examples of things that customers should do include the following:
 - Regularly check for, and repair, leaks inside and outside their home.
 - Don't leave the tap running when shaving, brushing teeth, and face washing.
 - Only water your landscape when necessary. Adjust sprinklers so only your lawn is watered and not the house, sidewalk or street.
